I ain't one to talk, so you ain't heard this from me

DRY RUN on President Obama's life.

Secret Service Officers allegedly performed a string of security lapses after Oscar Ramiro Ortega-Hernandez, then 21, shot at least seven bullets at the executive mansion in Washington from his vehicle in 2011. Although the president, the First Lady and their older daughter Malia were away at the time of the shooting, their younger daughter Sasha and Michelle Obama's mother, Marian Robinson, were inside. The agency's "fumbled" response to the shooting on Nov. 11, 2011, was detailed in a Washington Post investigation. According to the new report, it apparently took four days for the Secret Service to realize that gunshots had hit the Obama residence. In the incident, Ortega-Hernandez, fired his semi-automatic pistol out of the passenger window of his black Honda, which was parked south of the mansion. Secret Service officers rushed to respond to the shots, with one stationed under the second-floor terrace drawing her handgun, but the supervisor wrongly informed them: "No shots have been fired... stand down." The supervisor claimed the noise came from a nearby construction vehicle, the Washington Post reports. Even after it had been confirmed that gunshots were fired, the agency initially theorized rival gangs had gotten into a gunfight near the mansion's front lawn. Secret Service reportedly did not discover that the White House had been struck until four days later when a housekeeper noticed broken glass and a chunk of cement on the floor inside.

Then there's the Colombia escort Secret Service hooker scandal (May 7, 2012, Secret Service assigned to protect the President) where sensitive documents are alleged to have been left in the same room as the "Hooker" occupied. Meanwhile, White House officials have said the President's security was not compromised but investigators are looking into whether the agents left sensitive papers in their rooms, where the "hookers" could have had access to them. That kind of behavior is just too lucid to accept as speculation. Who are they fooling me, you? Wake up Brothas and Sistas, if they kill him, what y'all gon do? A Secret Service spokesman said the car entered the security checkpoint at 17th Street and Pennsylvania and was immediately stopped by Secret Service uniformed officers. The Secret Service identified the driver as Mathew Evan Goldstein, 55 years of age.

WASHINGTON (AP) — September 19, 2014 President Barack Obama and his daughters had just departed the White House on Friday evening when an intruder scaled the north fence, darted across the lawn and into the presidential residence. The U.S. Secret Service came under intense scrutiny after it was revealed that the man had a knife and made it all the way through to the interior quarters before being apprehended. The Secret Service identified the suspect as Omar J. Gonzalez, a 42-year-old man from Copperas Cove, Texas. Prosecutors said last week that Gonzales had 800 rounds of ammunition in his car, in addition to a machete and two hatchets.

Washington Post reporter, Carol D. Leonnig uncovered this incident. "A security contractor with a gun and three convictions for assault and battery was allowed on an elevator with President Obama during a Sept. 16 trip to Atlanta, Georgia, violating Secret Service protocols, according to three people familiar with the incident. The private contractor first aroused the agents' concerns when he acted oddly and did not comply with their orders to stop using a cellphone camera to record the president in the elevator, according to the people familiar with the incident. When the elevator opened, Obama left with most of his Secret Service detail. Some agents stayed behind to question the man and then used a national database check that turned up his criminal history."
